**DOGS WELCOME AT 12 FOUR SISTERS INNS;
POOCHES PAY HALF PRICE IN OFF SEASON**

(MONTEREY, CALIF.) – Can't bear to leave your best friend at home when you travel? If you're staying at one of the 12 Four Sisters Inns that welcome canine guests, you don't have to.

In California, special dog-friendly rooms are available at the Blue Lantern Inn (Dana Point), Channel Road Inn (Santa Monica), Hotel Casa 425 (Claremont), Gosby House Inn and Green Gables Inn (Pacific Grove), Seal Cove Inn (Moss Beach), West Cliff Inn (Santa Cruz), Blackbird Inn (downtown Napa), Lavender (Yountville in the Napa Valley), Inn at Sonoma (Sonoma) and Healdsburg Inn on the Plaza (Healdsburg). In Washington, dogs are welcome at the Inn at Harbor Steps (Seattle).

From Nov. 15, 2010 through April 30, 2011, dogs stay in the same room as their human companions for just \$32.50 (regular rate is \$65). This fee is for the entire stay, not "per night," and includes breakfast delivered to the room for the people, and special treats for the pooch. Dogs are also provided with a dog bowl and mat for use during their stay.

Guests bringing Fido along must note this at the time of booking, so that a dog-friendly room can be reserved; there are a limited number of rooms available for pets at each inn. Dog owners must be able to show proof of current vaccinations and license for their pets.
