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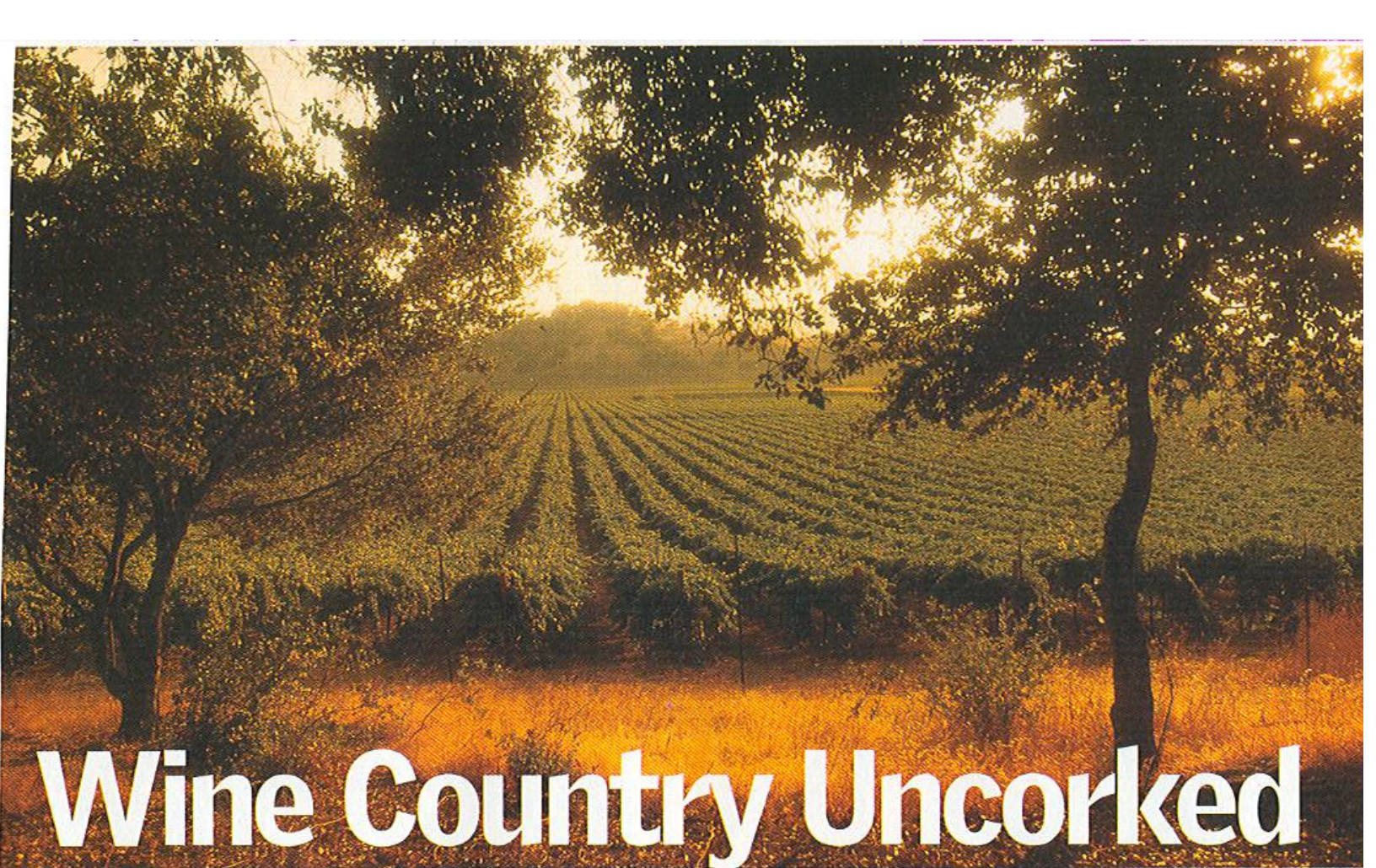
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Wine Country Uncorked

YOUNTVILLE Wandering the fragrant gardens of this ivy- and rose-covered complex, it's easy to imagine you're at a charming inn along a *route du vin* deep in the heart of Burgundy. The 19th-century brick-and-stone buildings, formerly a speakeasy, house 13 rooms with an airy, Gallic flair, thanks to French country antiques and rich fabrics. **Room to book:** The Bakery Building quarters are more spacious, but the main house has great vineyard views from the rooms upstairs. **What's nearby:** Within walking distance is Thomas Keller's fabled French Laundry restaurant.
